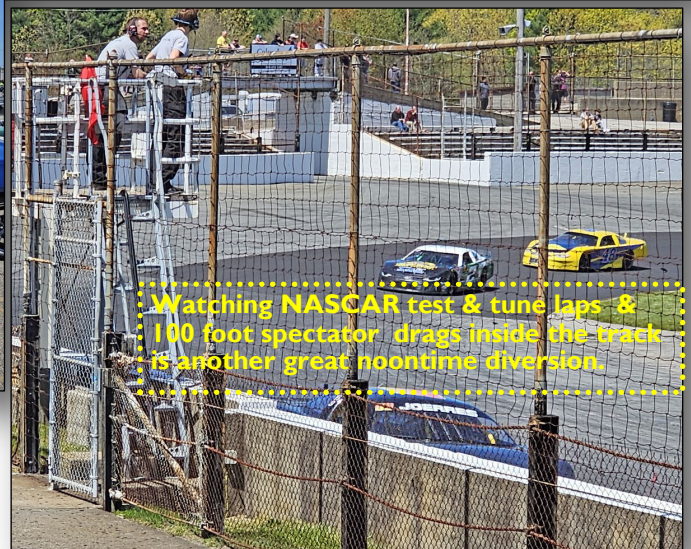


Seekonk Speedway 8th Annual Show & Go Car Show

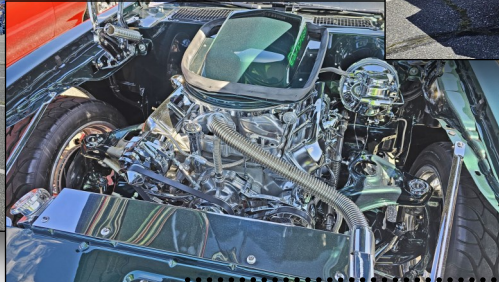

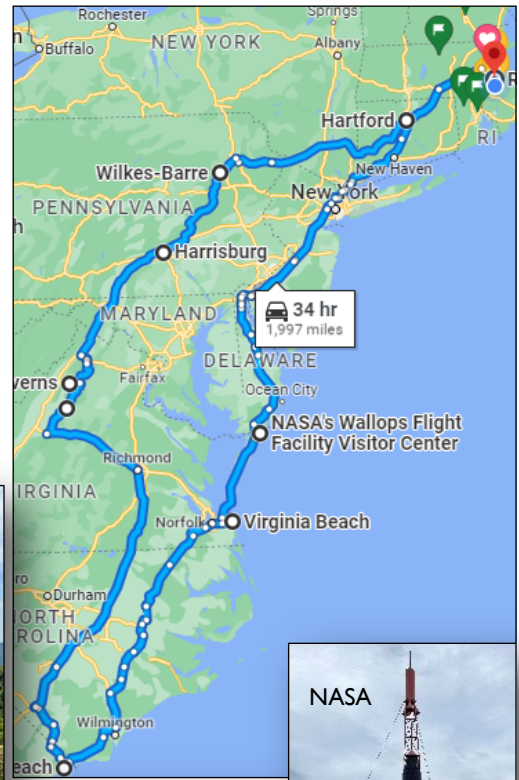

nights on the way down, two nights with our friends in South Carolina and two nights on the coastal return journey home.

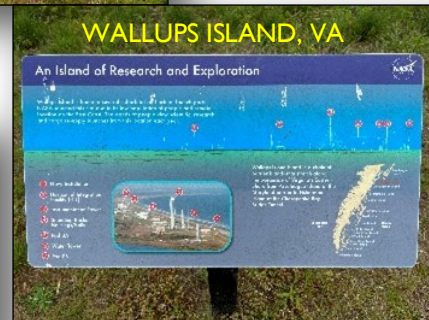

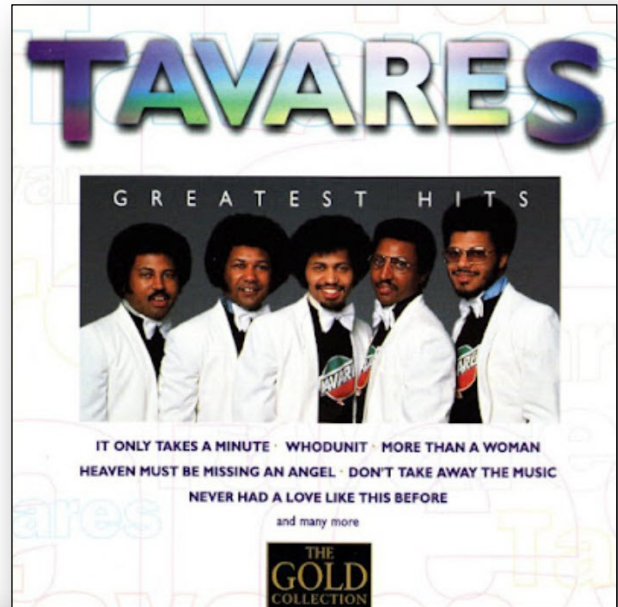


TAVARES Final Tribute Salute

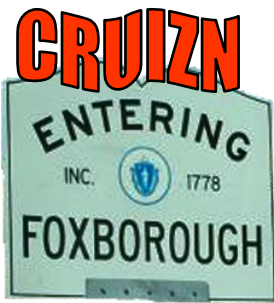
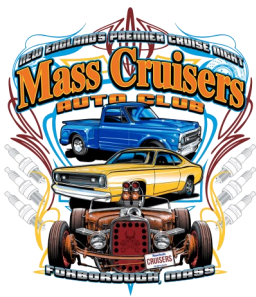
