



April 18 Guest Speaker: Abe's Garage By John Buchanan



Continuing with our monthly meeting Guest Speaker series, our newest Bass Pro Shops major sponsor, Ben Resnikoff, Abe's Garage co-owner with his brother Ted, attended our April 18 monthly meeting held in the Bass Pro Shops to tell us about their new concept in providing a profession garage space where you are the mechanic on your own collector car. Their climate controlled 20,000 sq. ft. state of the art professional garage located at 300 North Montello St. in Brockton was opened for business in October 2021 providing rental space where an auto enthusiast can get the most from the hobby with 24 hour 7 day week access to their car. The facility utilizes real-time video surveillance along with biometric security. They have three professional lifts with master mechanic toolsets in oversized work bays that can be rented by the hour, day or week to work on your vehicle. The two level facility can also accommodate up to 60 separate work and storage spaces available to rent on a month-to-month, winter or year-round storage. There are seven types of membership that range from social, where you can just hang out, to also attend events and classes and have access to their lifts and tools, to secured vault storage with work space. Ben shared how he and his brother's bad experience storing and working with their own project vehicles led to creating this unique facility that is tribute, named for their grandfather Abe who was in charge of the military motor pool on Bermuda during WW-II. Special ordered originally by a doctor with the then new Chrysler 331 Hemi dual quad carbs & 300 HP drivetrain with 150 mph speedo and special suspension and one month only two-tone Black &

Nugget Gold paint with St, Regis trim, he said he couldn't drive it so the dealer kept it in the showroom until it it was later sold to someone in Arizona. Tom bought it in 2009 and originally wanted to repaint it, but being such a rare model his crew undertook an unauthorized total nut and bolt restoration while he was hospitalized. When finished, he brought it to the Hemmings Concours in Saratoga where it took Best of Show and then to Hershey where it won its 1st National Award in 2013. A good customer of his from Newfoundland saw it there and bought it. Tom's youngest son contacted that owner in 2020 and bought it for Tom's 80th highbay and he's been driving it ever since proving that old adage.




