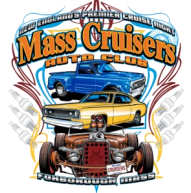

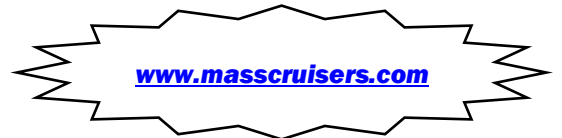

Board Musings

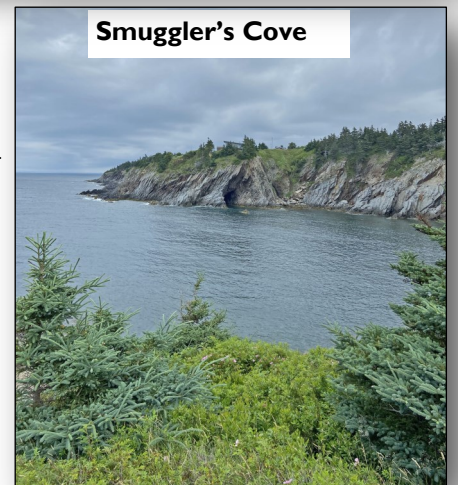


It all started with an innocent conversation with a friend of mine who told me about a car show that they go and help with every year in Yarmouth Nova Scotia that her uncle runs. Her mother who was born there came from a big family. Most of her aunts and uncles have stayed in Nova Scotia so going back home to help at the show gives her plenty of time to catch up with visiting them. Her uncle Paul belongs to the Roaring 20's Antique Auto Club based in Yarmouth.

Since Nova Scotia is a great place to visit, I thought, why not take in a car show and see the sights and sounds of NS. Putting it out to the club to see if anyone else was interested in taking a road trip, Joe Renaud and Ellen expressed an interest. After sitting down one night we had a plan all mapped out. Taking the 3pm Cat ferry out of Bar Harbor on Wednesday afternoon had us docking in Yarmouth at 7:30pm Atlantic Standard Time, an hour ahead of us. On Thursday we were treated to a BBQ at her uncle's camp situated on a beautiful lake. In the following days we visited several light houses and beaches, the Bay Of Fundy, Smugglers Cove and the town of Digby where the other ferry out of St. John docks.

At the Bay of Fundy there is a 28 feet difference between high and low tide. At low tide you literally can walk miles out on the mud flats before reaching water. Smugglers Cove is a natural made cave that cannot be seen at high tide. Only at a lower tide is it accessible by row boat which made it a popular hiding spot for rum runners during prohibition.

The show itself is very similar to the Old Orchard Beach car show. On Friday afternoon about 20 members of the Roaring 20's Antique Auto club met for a leisurely drive along the coast where we ended up at a restaurant for lunch. Then Friday night featured a parade of cars thru downtown Yarmouth. On Saturday morning downtown is closed to public traffic. Only show cars are allowed entrance with show cars angle parked on both sides of the street. It rained most of Saturday morning stopping before noon so this weather cut down on the amount of cars participating.



They normally get between 700 to 800 cars but the rain dropped those numbers down to the 400 to 500 range. A car show in Nova Scotia is no different than any back home. There where stock antiques, muscle cars, hot rods and rat rods. The quality of the cars is very much like what we are used to seeing. The biggest difference is seeing Canadian built cars like the Beaumont line of GM Canada's mid-size 1960's muscle cars based on the Chevelle like mine. There were several Best of Show awards given out. One of them went to Joe Renaud's 1956 Chevrolet pickup. Congratulations Joe.

Another return trip is in the future. This time we would like to venture further north visiting places like Cape Briton, Halifax, Prince Edwards Isle, and possibly Newfoundland.



June 29 Bass Pro Shops Cruise Night

Another great break for us on the weather front for our final month of June 29 Bass Pro Shops Cruise at Patriot Place in Foxborough, MA. We frequently get questioned on the number of cruise cars so Bob Walton used a hand operated counter while directing cars into the Lot 16 entrance where the Attleboro Hebron Food Pantry was set up to collect non-perishable food donations. Lot 16 & adjacent Lot 14 holds a net of 700 cars with the way we are set up and during the cruise we experience a turnover of cars with early afternoon arrivals starting to leave around 4:30 PM then being replaced by the late afternoon arrivals. For those who like to keep track, a total of 1,050 vehicles had been counted before show cars were diverted to the Lot 12 & 20 overflow lots by Patriot Place traffic control. Both the Classic Thunderbirds of New England and Wheels of Time Massachusetts, the featured car clubs, had good attendance and there were unique and first time visits by interesting cars shown below.

Don Rounds son tracked down his 1950's era dirt track stock car, bought it back, and created a traveling museum which he brought or our June 29 cruise to see and reminisce with us of those 1950's era area dirt race tracks.

June 29 Cruise Winner 1979 Dodge "Li'l Red Truck"

Cody Bausch's Canyon Red 1979 Dodge Adventurer 150 "Little Red Express" truck, selected to receive the Vintage Motorsports sponsored June 29 Cruise Award Plaque, is an unrestored original with a great backstory. Cody's grandfather bought the truck new in 1979 and, when he passed, Cody's uncle in Alabama bought it and kept it until he passed two years ago turning the family caretaking responsibilities on to Cody who had it trailered back home to Norfolk, Massachusetts. The Li'l Red Truck was only a two year 1978-79 performance package that Dodge put together on a short 114-inch wheelbase, two-wheel drive chassis. Powered with the 225-horsepower, EH1-code police package 360-cubic-inch V-8 and 3 speed 727 transmission, the Adventurer package included power steering, old West-styled gold 3M pinstriping tape decals on the tailgate and doors, oak body trim panels, bright front and rear bumpers, raised white-outline-letter Goodyear radial tires on 15-inch chromed Western five-slot wheels. And we can't forget those unique dual vertical exhaust pipes with chromed exhaust tips, and polished heat shields. Yep, this Lil Red Truck would definitely fit in my garage if I could find one as nice as Cody's.





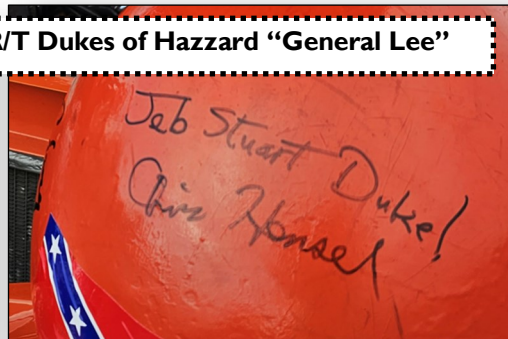
July 13 Bass Pro Shops Cruise Night

The new normal for traditional custom and classic car owners that have been the backbone of the weekend car show and weekly cruising scene for decades includes welcoming the evolution of our hobby which encompasses the integration of foreign marques and modified late model sport cars like the July 13 Vintage Motorsports Cruise Award selection, Phil Solar's highly personalized 2020 Toyota Supra in standout Nitro Yellow (Lightening Yellow) finish. Add on the rear color matched trunk spoiler and custom Thule roof carrier that's put to good use holding all the protective mats and undercarriage chassis mirror and you are drawn closer to see what other upgrades he made. It is a treat to watch the air ride suspension lower the body to an angled position that allows placement of a mirror under the rear chassis to view the one-off custom Titanium exhaust system, . Opening the hood allows viewing of the custom detail touches added to enhance its BMW-sourced inline 6 cylinder turbocharged 3.0 liter engine putting out 335 hp @ 5,000 RPM & 365 ft-lb of torque connected to an 8 speed automatic tranny with Porsche's PDK dual-clutch that provides for fast, firm refined upshifts when on the track. Of course that's where the HRE Performance wheels & all-season Michelin low profile pilot sport tires for track come into play when the opportunity rises. Then there's the custom black leather interior where Phil replaced the grey stitching & piping using matching yellow thread...WOW!



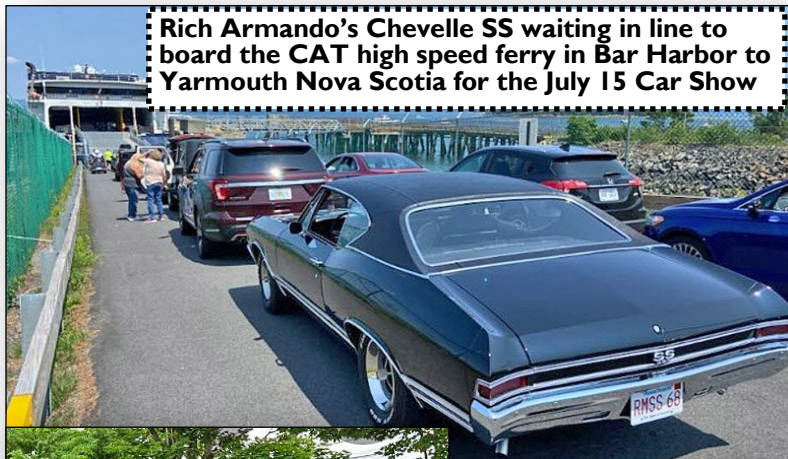

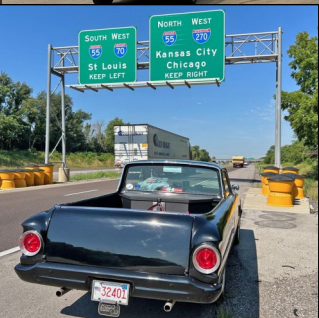

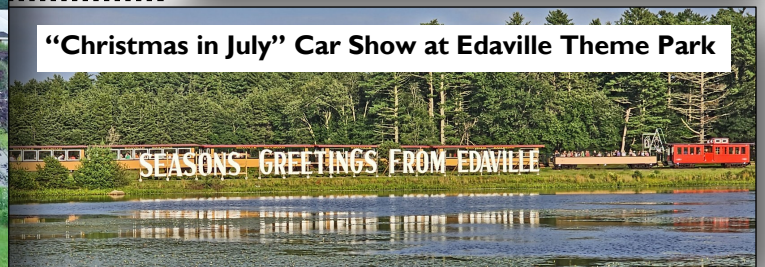
