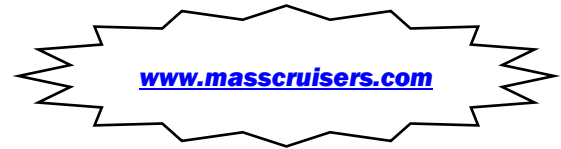

CLUB EVENTS: If you missed this month's meeting there are several events mentioned that you should be aware of. Emails about these events have been sent out to members with all the details on meet-up times, locations and who to contact if a headcount is needed, Please make a note of them and try to attend if you have the time.

CRUISE NIGHT WINNER SELECTION changes to the cruise nights that you should know about. Bob Hines and I went over several ideas and thought that a new procedure should be put in place for the remainder of our 2022 cruise season. Starting at the June 2 cruise, the car of the night will be selected by two club members who regularly work the cruise nights. Since we now have only 10 cruise nights left we thought having a team of two would give more members a chance to select a car of their liking. This will be a reward for working the cruise night and also will give a wider range of diversity with the types of cars being selected. We will put together a list of who will be picking the cars and what night will be your turn. The next thing we will institute is a rewards program where if you work the cruise nights there will be some sort of a thank you for everyone after the cruise season. You do not have to make every night, just the majority of them. Just by showing up does not make you eligible for the list. You actually have to work most of the night.

CRUISE CANCELLATIONS: Here is something that I feel is necessary to mention. That is the procedure that Bob and I go through before canceling a cruise night due to weather. After seeing some of the foolish comments by some of our Facebook members when we make cancellations due to forecasted weather conditions at our hilltop Patriot Place venue an explanation is needed. A decision has to be made by 10:00am the day of the cruise night. If the advanced weather forecast is for no chance of improvement and the sun not coming out by noon then the cruise is canceled. What people don't realize is that putting on our cruise night incurs significant expense and resources for both of our hosts, Patriots Place and the Bass Pro Shops. When a cruise night is held the DJ, portable toilets, dumpster, police detail and parking security staff all have to be called in that morning. In good conscious why incur the expense for all of these services when there may be a poor turnout. We also have to take into consideration our new food vendor and site restaurants that also may have to call in extra help along with prepping the extra food they plan on having available during the cruise. Finally we have to consider the effect on our own members who volunteer their time. This is why once a decision is made we go with it with no second guessing. Most everyone is always smarter after the fact and some will never understand or even care based on some of the comments I have seen posted on social media.

The Bay State Antique Auto Club is experiencing the same problem many clubs are faced with conducting judged car shows. The BSAAC is faced with a large car show and not enough help to judge the cars expected to turn out on their Sunday July 10th. Show in Dedham. Chief judge Carl Edwards has asked if the Mass Cruisers would like to lend a hand with judging. After a discussion at our monthly meeting it was voted on to have anyone who wants to judge at this show to go as an individual. Encore for the 1946 Ford Coupe May 5 Cruise Winner

Bob Mucciarone's custom 1946 Ford Club Coupe Street Rod was a previous Vintage Motorsports cruise winner back in May 2016, but the car has since undergone a Deep Red Metallic repaint in Florida that was applied by Bob's nephew Scott Sarrica during the COVID-19 pandemic. The stunning custom color selection was a collaboration by Bob's wife and his nephew. Bob prepped the car for the repaint by scaping off the old Saab Merlot red paint finish using safety razors before shipping it off to Florida to his nephew for the makeover. The car still retains its Ford 302 V8 and T4 tranny with the 8 inch 3:00 rear, vintage air A/C, Wilwood front & rear disc brakes, American Racing 15 inch Wheels and the custom black vinyl upholstery that Bob did. Bob, who is retired, was a mechanic and service technician at Rodman Ford for 33 years. He bought the coupe 18 years ago when it had already been customized with a 5 inch top chop and 2 inch body channel with an era correct louvered hood. After 3 years of driving it, Bob tore it apart and began a total rebuild starting with the suspension then next the power train and finally the custom black vinyl interior and finishing it with that previous unusual Saab Merlot red color paint. There is no doubt that Bob's wife's 2021 color

collaboration with nephew Scott's skilled application made Bob's coupe fresh new color "pop" at our May 5 cruise. And it also made a huge impression, along with being a beautifully detailed Ford-in-a-Ford custom, on our Assistant Cruise Director Bob Hines who was charged with selecting the night's cruise winner (left).

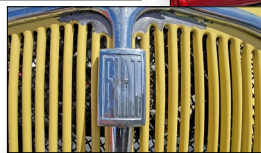

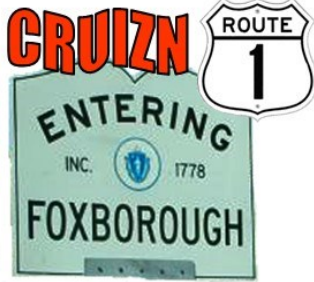
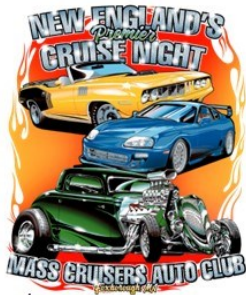
