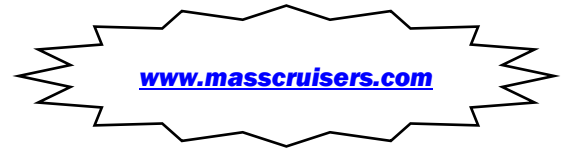

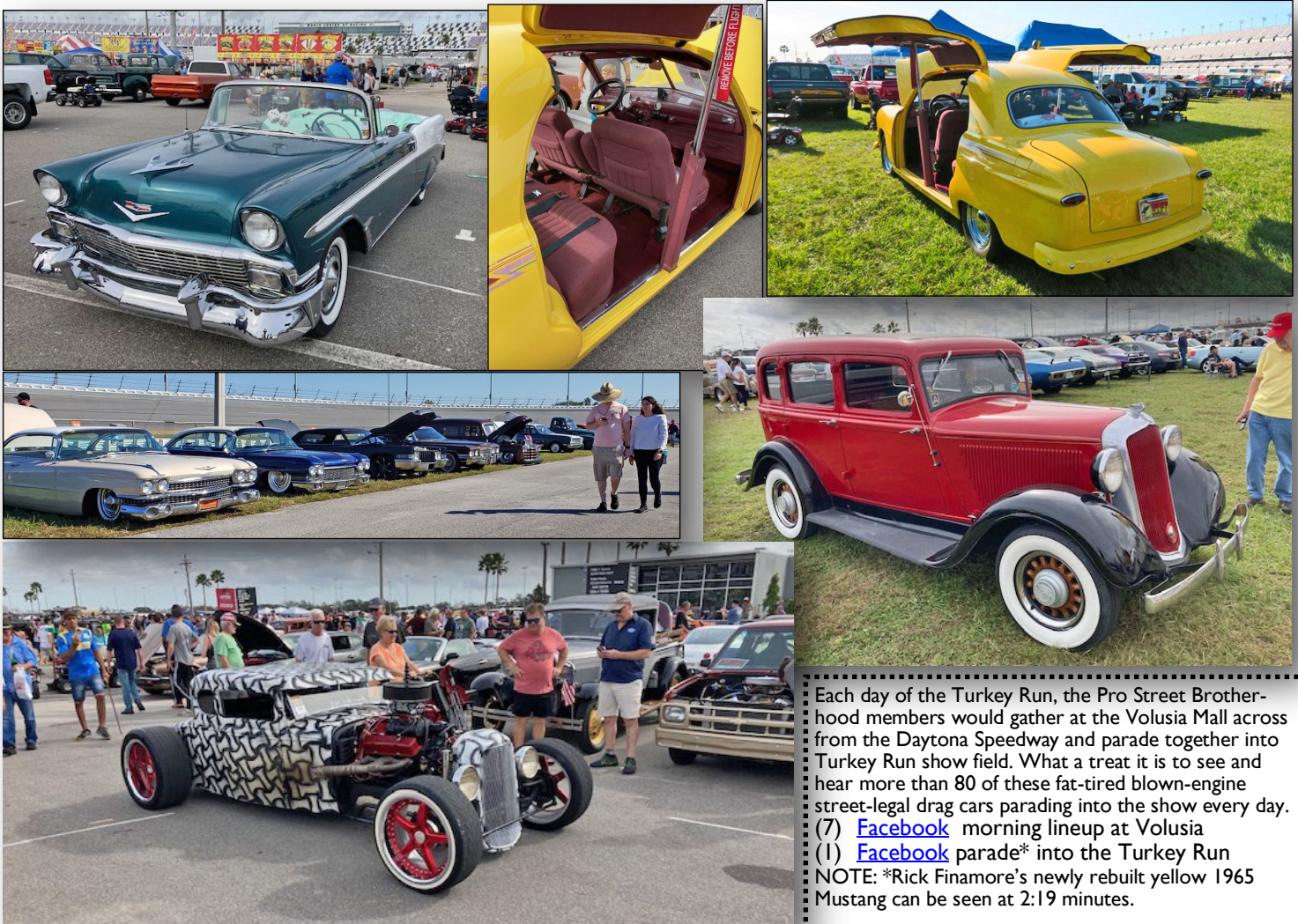
49th Annual Daytona Turkey Run 2022

Walking into the show through the main entrance to the track was overwhelming with what to cover and walking the 180 acre infield where the show is held; should have rented a golf cart to save my legs and waning energy level. If you survive the 8 AM—4 PM day at the track, you can grab something to eat and relax a bit before hitting the Turkey Run Nights, cruise night across from the track at the One Daytona Shopping Mall property. It is well worth the planning a trip to Florida over a Thanksgiving weekend for the 50th Annual Turkey Run in 2023 but be sure to make reservations early. I plan to attend next year's 50th. Hope to see you there. If you can't make it for the 50th Fall Turkey Run there is the 33rd Annual Spring Turkey Run to be held on March 24-26, 2023. 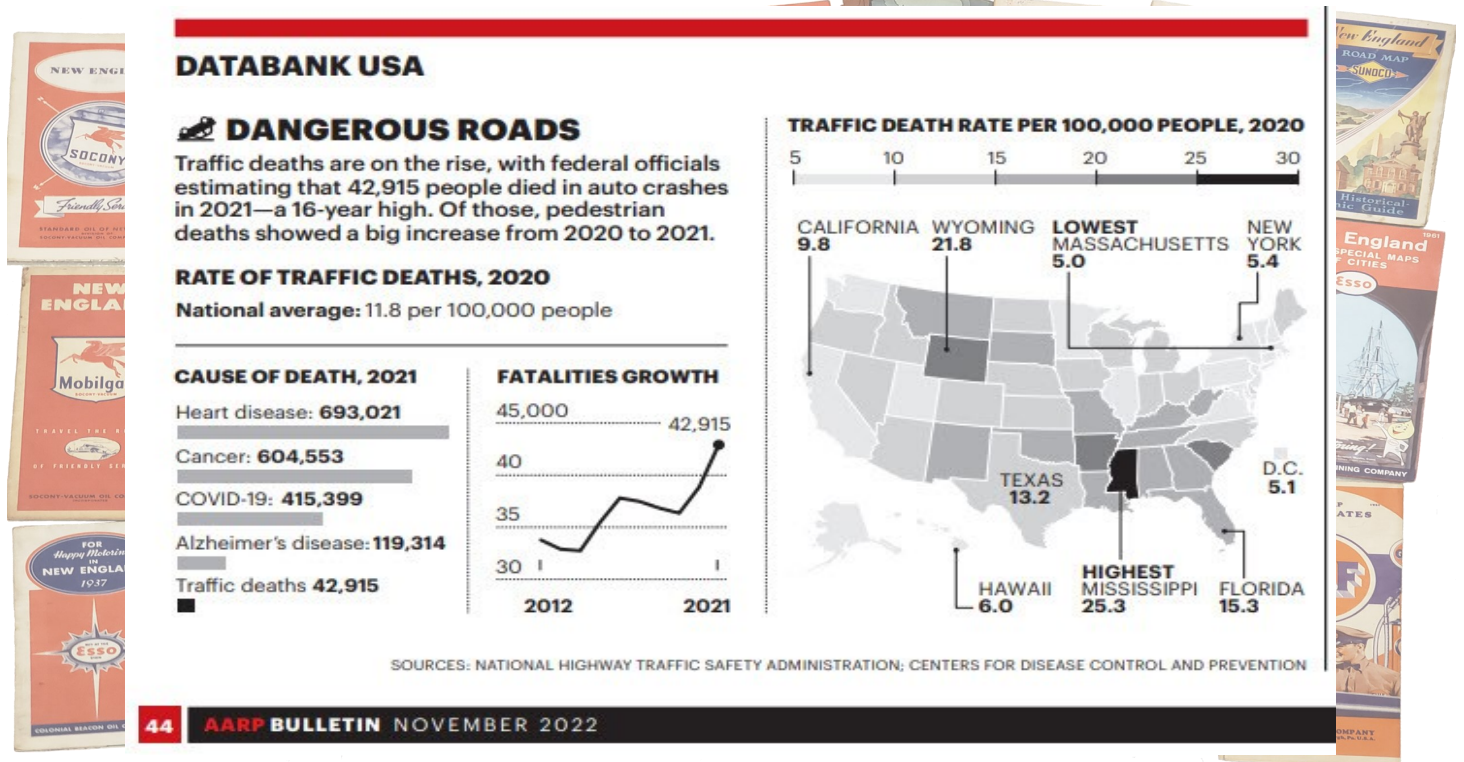


America's Dangerous Roads

I've always felt safer and more relaxed driving the back roads whether it be a cross-country road trip or to the nearest mall or auto parts store. Some might feel our own state of Massachusetts might be on the NHTSA's nasty list of dangerous roads, however a "DATABANK USA" graphic published in the November 2022 AARP BULLETIN illustrated the most dangerous roads based on traffic deaths showed, we are not. Although there was a significant rise in auto crash deaths in 2021 to a 16 year high of almost 43,000, the good news was that Massachusetts enjoyed the lowest number of U.S. traffic deaths per 100,000 people at 5 in 2020 while Mississippi being the highest at 25.3.



Despite Massachusetts enjoying the lowest number of traffic deaths compared to the rest of the country, lane departure crashes are one of the primary fatal crash types in Massachusetts. The Commonwealth exceeds the national average for the proportion of fatal lane departure crashes and was designated a lead state in lane departure crashes by the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO). Within our state there are locally well known roads experiencing more accidents than others. There are a number of top 5 lists from accident specialty law firms showing the most accident prone roads and intersections that are familiar to many of us that regularly travel on our state's highways:

- The I-95/Route 128 split
- I-90 The Massachusetts Turnpike interchange with I-495
- I-93 from Canton passing through downtown Boston
- Rte. 24
- Storrow Drive

So, continue to drive safely and stay alert when driving those known accident prone roads.
