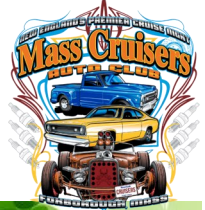

Editor's Musing

At the February Mass Assoc. of Auto Clubs Board meeting we learned the good news from M.A.A.C.'s Lobbyist, Jack Bartley, that Governor Charlie Baker signed HB4722 into law in the 11th hour of his final tenure. HB4722, an Act relative to the sale of old metals and vehicle catalytic converters was sponsored by Representative Steven Howitt (R) 4th Bristol (Norton/Rehoboth/Seekonk/Swansea) . Those of us familiar with how difficult it is moving a bill through the Massachusetts two-year General Court session when facing competition from more than 8,000 other bills recognize the importance of having an experienced lobbyist assisting in ushering a bill to the finish line. In the last few weeks of the 192nd General Court, Jack Bartley formed a coalition with law enforcement, auto dealers, auto manufacturers and insurance companies to support passage of HB4722. This bill requires every person licensed to purchase, sell, barter or deal in old metals to record all transactions. The record will include the transaction date, name, address, telephone number and signature of the person transacting the sale or receipt; a photo of the person or their photo I.D.; the license plate & vehicle V.I.N. used to transport when applicable; description, photo of the old metals; copy of any legal ownership documents and the price paid or received. Records must be retained for 2 years from the transaction date for old metals and 3 years for catalytic converters. It also includes violation penalties including fines, imprisonment and community service.

Although there have been waves of thefts that included copper pipe, electric wiring and bronze statuary over the years when those scrap metal prices rose, the surge in thefts of vulnerable high value catalytic converters from parked vehicles and the ease of converting those thefts to cash payouts without any records became epidemic in recent years. Our thanks goes to Rep. Steven Howitt for persisting in getting a legislative solution in place with HB4722 and to Jack Bartley for facilitating the forces necessary to help move Rep. Howitt's bill along to the Governor for his signature. Hopefully surrounding states will follow.

Guest Speakers Detail Garage Swansea

We are getting back into the swing of inviting our Bass Pro Shops Cruise sponsors to be guest speakers at our monthly meetings. This February 21st meeting was with brothers Andrew and Gary Sousa, owners of their popular Auto Detailing Supplies franchise Detail Garage located at 207 Swansea Mall Drive on Rte. 118 off U.S. Route 6. Why is it popular? What sets them apart from other detail supply stores, in addition to having a great Chemical Guys product line are their wildly popular monthly 11 AM—2 PM last-Sunday-of-the-month cruise-ins that typically attract several hundred cars and trucks. Because of their popularity, they were pressed by customers and followers to start their first 2023 cruise on March 26. So, it appears we can look forward to this month of March opening up with a couple of swap meets, the March 5th annual MARCOM flea market at the Holmes Transportation Barn in Norfolk and ending with the Detail Garage's opening season cruise-in on Sunday March 26.

Much of the discussion at the meeting surrounded questions from members about the current trend of using ceramic coatings to protect their vehicle's paint finish due to its reputation for needing a minimum of cleaning effort to remove dirt, resistance against swirl marks and preventing waterspotting due to the coating's hydrophilic properties. The **PROS** are: **1.** Easy to clean; **2.** U.V. protection from paint deterioration; **3.** less damage from minor scratches and swirl marks; **4.** Oh, and that GLOSSY look for up to six years that looks like it was just waxed; **5.** provides protection against some chemicals & acids. The **CONS** are: **1.** Doesn't provide protection against rock chips & heavy scratches; **2.** doesn't provide 100% protection against water spots; **3.** ceramic coatings aren't cheap and may require significant prep correction before applying; **4.** Paint defects will be sealed with no way to hide them after coating and it does magnify them just as it does for a beautiful paint finish. **5.** the coating requires curing time for two or three weeks to ensure maximum protection so it has to stay garaged or covered to prevent dirt, bugs, bird droppings or pollen sticking to the surface. **6.** when properly applied, the coating doesn't peel off when it ages which is a PRO, it just slowly gets thinner and disappears so it is hard to determine when it has completely worn off. When all was said and done, my question was, what about carnauba waxes? Andrew responded he still prefers waxing over ceramic coatings despite the additional time and effort required to maintain them to the same level that ceramic coatings provide.

Although Detail Garage Swansea wants to become your go-to source for cleaning, detailing supplies from Chemical Guys and provide technical advice they do not provide detailing or finishing services but, they do offer monthly hands-on training classes for both beginners and professional detailers. They also provide on-site demonstrations during their monthly Sunday cruises and offered to use one of our club member's cars as demo at one of the upcoming cruise-ins. Who wants to volunteer? Thank you Andrew and Gary.
