

May 2 Bass Pro Shops Cruise

Oh well, rain prevented our April 18 Bass Pro Shops cruise season opener from happening, but Mother Nature smiled on our Thursday May 2 cruise date and well over a thousand cruise cars were able to find their way to Patriot Place in Foxborough, MA.; it couldn't have been any better.

One new addition this year is a revival of the Patriot Place courtesy shuttle van with six stops that will be operating from 4 PM until 9 PM. The first "STOP 1" is at our <u>Mass Cruisers cruise car entrance</u> crosswalk (shown in picture below); STOP 2 - <u>Bass Pro Shops</u>; STOP 3—<u>Olive Garden</u>; STOP 4—<u>Wormtown Brewery</u>; STOP 5—<u>Bar Louie</u>; STOP 6—<u>Six String Grill</u>. Look for the signs to wait for the van to be shuttled to the South and North Market sponsored stops and return back to the cruise.

We have a new large thermometer sign at the cruise entrance to display this year's progress on surpassing last year's \$31,000 collection for the five area food pantries in addition to the more than 9 tons of non-perishable food. \$1 donation allows the food pantries to purchase \$20 of food from the Boston area food bank.

The 50-50 proceeds will be funding tool grants that are increased \$400 to \$700 this year and given to graduating seniors from the participating area Technical/Vocational High Schools. Also, we are still collecting your old or duplicate tools that will be given to these students. They can be dropped off at our club trailer.





May 2 Cruise Winner 1959 Chrysler 300E Coupe

One of the two cars selected at the May 2 Cruise by the team of Marie Armando & Diane Reizovic was Ed Finn's black 1966 Chrysler 330 Convertible. When asked how long he owned the car, Ed said 3 years and when asked about its history he said it was a customer of his who had restored it and when he couldn't pay his snow plowing bill, offered the car as payment. Ed said it turned out to be a good deal for him be-

cause this car is more fun to go for ice cream with his wife than it was with the 1973 Chevy Vega that he had been driving. The Chrysler 300 high performance luxury letter series ended with the 300L in 1965 when they introduced these 300 non-letter series in 1966. The letter series would not re-appear until 1998 with the 300M. This unlettered 300 is no slouch though with a big block 440 V8 putting out 365 HP and 3-speed TorqueFlite transmission with a console mounted tachometer, Ed's convertible is outfitted in black leather interior and also comes with factory air conditioning, but for cruising it was a top down drive to Foxborough.

















May 2 Cruise Winner 1966 Chrysler 300 Convertible

Dave Larsen has previously refused our cruiser award honor for his Radiant Red 1959 Chrysler 300E Coupe stating, "let someone else be selected". It finally took the cruise judging team of Diane Thornton & Lorna Rabbitt, a professed lover of these old Chrysler letter cars, to convince Dave to become one of the two cruise cars selected at the May 2 cruise. Two cars were selected for today's cruise due to the rained-out April 18 season opening cruise. Dave, who hails from Millis, has owned this rare letter car for 12 years. Of the 550 300E Coupes built in 1959, 118 are known to have survived and Dave's is one particularly nice 300E Coupe and is driven regularly to area cruises and car shows garnering its share of awards along the way. In addition to the car's striking red paint, wide white wall tires and swept rear wing style fenders, there are other hidden gems in this car that get our enthusiast juices flowing. Under the hood sits Chrysler's iconic wedge 413 cu. in./380 HP V8 with dual 4 bbl Carter Carburetors and Chrysler 3 speed TorqueFlite automatic transmission with push button shift on the dashboard. Top speed was 132 mph and could do 0-60 mph in 7.8 sec. & 0 - ½ mi. in 15.7 sec @ 91 mph, not too shabby for a big heavy luxury car even today. Dave's 300E also has the optional swivel front leather bucket seats for easy enter and exit from the car, truly a unique feature of the early Chrysler automobiles.

IMPA SPRING BRAKE





I attended an event sponsored by the International Motor Press Association called Spring Brake this May where I had the opportunity to drive more than a dozen new vehicles provided by the auto manufacturers. The one I found the most unusual was the latest product from Honda called the "Motocompacto". This miniscule product in Japan is meant to get people from their train station stops to their place of work or business, or other places where cars don't fit or are not welcome. The impetus for this "vehicle" was major Japanese cities like Tokyo (10 million), Yokohama (4 million) and Osaka (3 million) which relies heavily on public transportation, has no free parking and what parking does exist, is very expensive or exclusive. The Motocompacto in its folded state, is slightly larger than a brief case and weighs just forty-one pounds. This is about equal to the lightest weight foldable ebike available in the U.S. Unfolded, it can take one passenger as far as seven miles at a maximum speed of fifteen miles per hour. The seat is tiny, but comfortable. Power to the front wheel electric motor is controlled by a small lever operated by the right thumb. Your left hand activates the single, rear wheel brake with a hand grip such as is found on most bicycles. Near one's left thumb is a very polite "ding, dong" bell. It has a small but effective kickstand. There are "pegs" for your feet. It took me only a minute or so to get used to handling this machine. This product is not for everyone but may be perfect for some. For example, race teams can use these to get around the vast expanses of racetracks. The flat sides of the Motocompacto are intentionally left blank so teams, corporations, or individuals can apply their own graphics. It is my understanding that

these will be available literally "over the counter" at the parts department of Honda dealers for \$995!







Santos Garage Tour #4


