

# Guest Speaker Jeff Goldstein (Piston Palace)

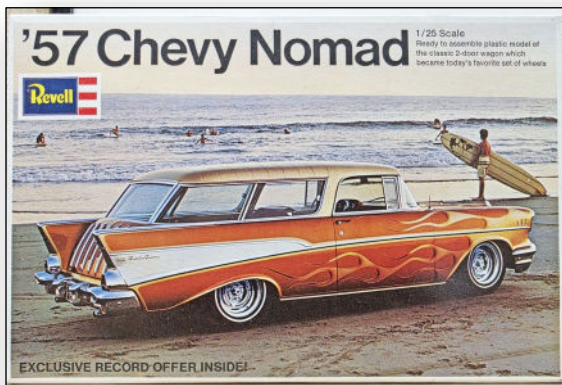

Back in November and December 2023 Jeff Goldstein hosted two separate tours of his private "PISTON PALACE" museum collection for club members that was coordinated by Fred Tierney. It was an awesome tour that included the unique models created by students in the Fisher Body Craftsmen Guild competitions each year. The Piston Palace also featured the range of cars in Jeff's hot rod, custom and antique car collection in two unique areas, the 1950-60's GM auto showroom and the Speed Equipment shop. When the question asked recently, "What happens to all these cars and collections when you die?", Jeff started thinking about his private museum becoming a 501C3 to make it more accessible to the general public. A part of that process too is providing a more detail history and personalized background of each of the items and collections he's gathered and restored over the years rather than the abridged "Readers Digest" version used when he conducts personal guided tours. And, that was what Jeff did for us at our March 17 Monthly meeting. Although Jeff provided comprehensive stories of how he started on this path of building collections ranging from when he purchased his first car at age 15 to how he came about building his Piston Palace Museum. A typical example, and my favorite story, because it's something we all can relate to was of a 12 year old Jeffrey saving money to buy his first Revell model kit, a beautiful custom 1957 Chevy Nomad Station Wagon, only to be discouraged on opening the box and seeing a white plastic model body with no decals, paint or instructions on how to make it look like the beautiful picture on the box cover. His first attempt making the model was a disaster and repeated attempts also failed. Fast forward to 2010 when Jeff is reading an article about those original California Nomad builders were replicating that famous Revell Nomad model used for the kit as the original was destroyed in an accident and restored back to its original factory condition, not the cool looking customized version. Jeff flew out to California and negotiated purchasing the repro and it now sits in the Piston Palace Speed Equipment showroom peeking out of the glassed garage sales window. I remembered that car on our 2023 club tour and hope members get a chance to visit the Piston Palace. We want to thank Jeff for sharing his stories with us and will follow up with his invitation to host another tour for club members at his Piston Palace museum.

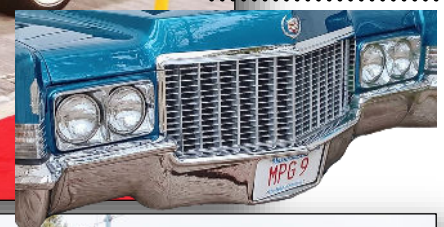

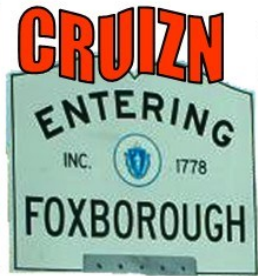
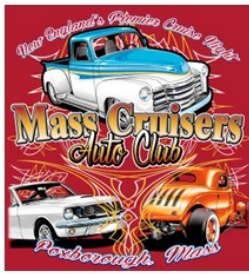
