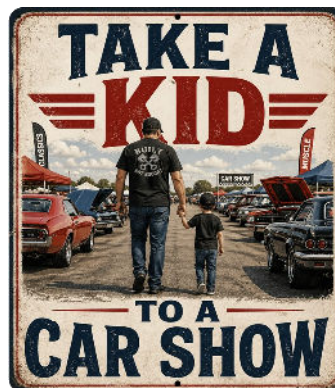

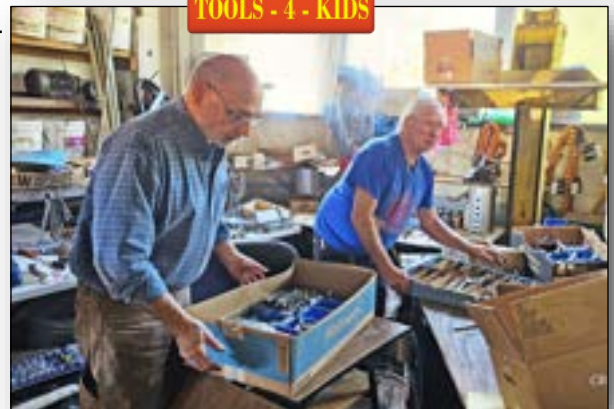


## Editor's Musing

If you missed seeing our opening cruise Vintage Motorsports Award winning selection, John Schiavo's Calypso Coral 1969 Mustang Mach 1 BOSS 302, keep an eye out for it as John plans to become a regular Bass Pro Shops Cruise cruiser with it. Only recently finished 3 1/2 weeks earlier off an 8 1/2 year build, John, owner of Avenue Auto Body in Boston, bought this mid- 1980's unfinished project which was a mess in 2016 as a creative challenge and it came out as a spectacular example of how a resto-mod muscle era pony car can be done. The body mods alone were so carefully executed that the untrained eye sees only a beautiful Mustang whereas Mustang owners like me can only dream about owning one like this one that John created. Underpinning the Mustang body is the Heidt's Ford 1965-70 Mustang Pro-G Independent front and rear suspension. It is powered by the legendary BOSS 302, but not all 302's are created equal. John's is a stroker modified to output 505 HP at the flywheel and with a Borg Warner T5 tranny coupled to a 3:24 Ford 9 in. rear & Heidt's coil over shocks, 4 bar link rear, IFS and rack & pinion steering, it's got to be a hoot to drive. No back seat drivers allowed as that space is filled with a custom built speaker system that helps drown out any highway noise. CONGRATULATIONS!

# 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary U.S. Interstate Highway System

Massachusetts motorists were very happy to pony up \$100 and get the RMV's striking commemorative 250th Anniversary plates. July 4th, 1776 is when the Declaration of Independence was adopted and coincidentally it was also the 200th Anniversary when former Presidents Adams and Jefferson died. Curious about whether or not the 100th Anniversary of the U.S. Interstate Highway System that was established on November 11, 1926 was listed among the more than 110 Major Anniversaries in U.S. History listed for 2026 on TheHistoryList.com. It wasn't. However the 105th Anniversary of the dedication of the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier was. The list also includes the 80th Anniversary of the Bikini making its debut in Paris on July 5th, and it wasn't very warm that July in 1946.

If recognition of our important transcontinental highway system isn't getting noticed by mainstream America, at least the Route 66 Centennial celebration [Route 66 Centennial](#) is well underway with each of the eight states from Illinois to California that it passes through is having planned festivals and parades in recognition of this historic milestone. I also have not found any of the other historic U.S. Route numbered highway organizations planning centennial celebrations, although U.S. Route 20 [100 Years of Route 20 - Historic Route 20](#) which starts in Boston and ends at the Pacific Coast Highway 101 in Newport Oregon is looking for ideas. I know those of us that love driving our cars, whether they be daily drivers or collectable show cars, do have bucket list drives and Route 66 is probably the number 1 road on our list. I did Route 66 in my 1961 Impala with my son in 2015 and I also did a month long cross country drive on U.S. Route 20 a.k.a. The Yellowstone Highway, from Boston to Newport Oregon down the Pacific Coast Highway to Long Beach, CA and back to Provincetown on U.S. Route 6 a.k.a The Grand Army of the Republic Highway in 2013. I don't think my aging body could have waited to pull any of these road trips during the centennial though. I do love the mantra though that goes like this, "Life is too short to drive boring cars." And equally important, "Drive your Chevrolet through the USA, America's the greatest land of all".

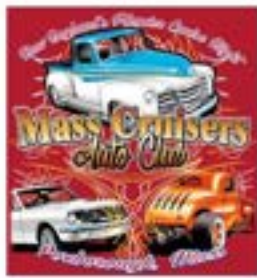
