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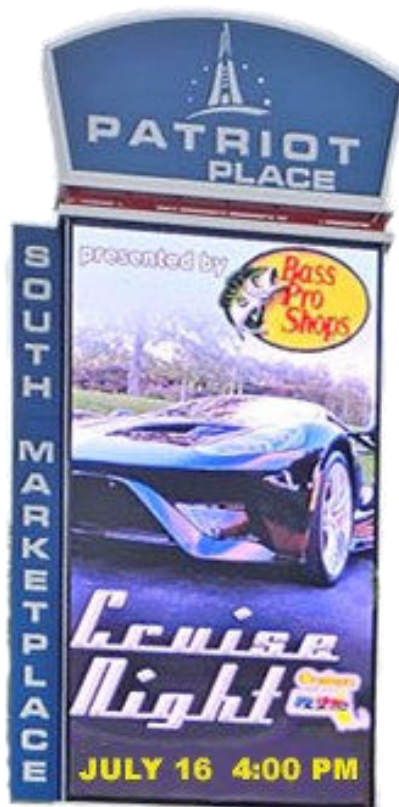

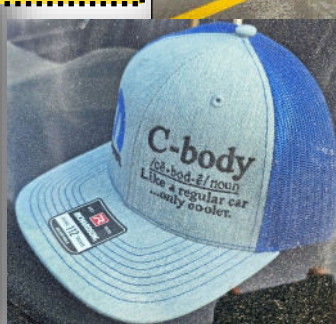
It isn't often that we experience what I consider perfect cruising weather; lets hope it continues when July 16 rolls around and we get back on our regular schedule.

June 4 1931 Model AA Dually Dump Truck Winner

The Massachusetts State Police Museum docents brought several of the museum's historic state police vehicles to the June 4th Bass Pro Shops cruise and were asked to select their favorite vehicle from the more than twelve hundred that were being displayed to receive one of the two Vintage Motorsports sponsored cruiser-of-the-night awards. They picked Norfolk resident Vincent Guerini's 1931 Ford Model AA dually dump truck which is regular cruise participant driving his AA truck from his nearby Norfolk home. Vincent found his AA dually up in Maine with its newly restored oak closed cab and chassis about 10 years ago. It took him a few weeks to get it road worthy. Ford originally sold these AA's as bare chassis with or without cabs, and with a 3.3L (201 cu. in.) 40 HP flathead 4 cylinder in-line engines & 4-speed manual transmissions so they could be customized for virtually any industry by after market builders. Vincent then found the dump body it now sports three years later and installed its manual crank which is always a treat to watch as he works the hand crank to lift it into its dump position. Looking at the six formidable 6:00 x 20-inch wheels and tires you realize this truck was built to handle heavy loads. Ford built 663,000 1927-1932 1.5 Ton chassis with about 300,000 of them equipped with open & closed factory cabs. It's always a treat to see another versatile work example of these early Model AAs.





June 4 1965 Chrysler 300 2-Dr Hardtop Winner

The featured June 4th Bass Pro Shops cruise C Body Chrysler owners (1965-1970 Fury, VIP, Custom 880, 300, Newport, New Yorker, Polara, Monaco) were asked to select their favorite among the cars being displayed to receive one of the two Vintage Motorsports cruiser-of-the-night awards being presented. They picked 17-year old Matthew Boiardi's black 1965 Chrysler 300 2-door hardtop. Although not the typical professionally museum quality Grade 1 100 point vehicle that some would expect to be selected from the more than 1,200 vehicles that showed up, the story behind Matt's cruise winner is what this hobby is all about. Matt, who also happens to own four other registered cars, another two project cars and a couple of parts cars, was helping a friend put together this former 1965 Chrysler 300 basket case he had bought when he had to move to England in March 2025. Because Matt had put more work into restoring it than the owner, he sold it to Matt. Matt continued to complete the restoration over the past year and get it on the road with the help of his dad and friends that also included our D.J. Bruce Palmer who also helped wrench on her. These C Body owners are a unique community of enthusiasts that will congregate at Chryslers at Carlisle when they can. If fact fellow club member Mike Rabbitt reported that one of these fellow Carlisle C-Body buddies flew from his Nebraska home to attend our June 4 cruise because the C-Bodies were being featured. It's a good thing we didn't have a 10 AM rain cancellation situation like our two previous cruises. Regardless, with all the concerns about the current generation carrying on the tradition to support our hobby, it's great to see teens like Matt stepping up in winning fashion. Our Local Food Pantry Collections

So far 2026 has been a roller coaster of a cruise season. Out of five scheduled nights, we experienced 2 rain outs, 2 cruises with over 1,200 cars each and one cloudy/showery evening with about 700 cars. Despite all of this, your donations that our cruise front entrance volunteers collected amounted to \$10,000. This resulted with each of the five supported area pantries receiving \$2,000 checks ahead of the summer school vacation season which is a critical period when donations are at their slowest and families no longer have the school lunch programs available for their children. We have been encouraging cash donations rather than non-perishable food because a \$1 donation allows the pantries, which are part of the Boston Area Food Bank network, to purchase \$20 equivalent food needed to support their programs. This appears to be working very well. Your cash donations also reduces the work required to inspect for expired food or damaged packaging which must be disposed of. 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Cruisin' at the speed of fun Annual Norfolk Lions Community Day

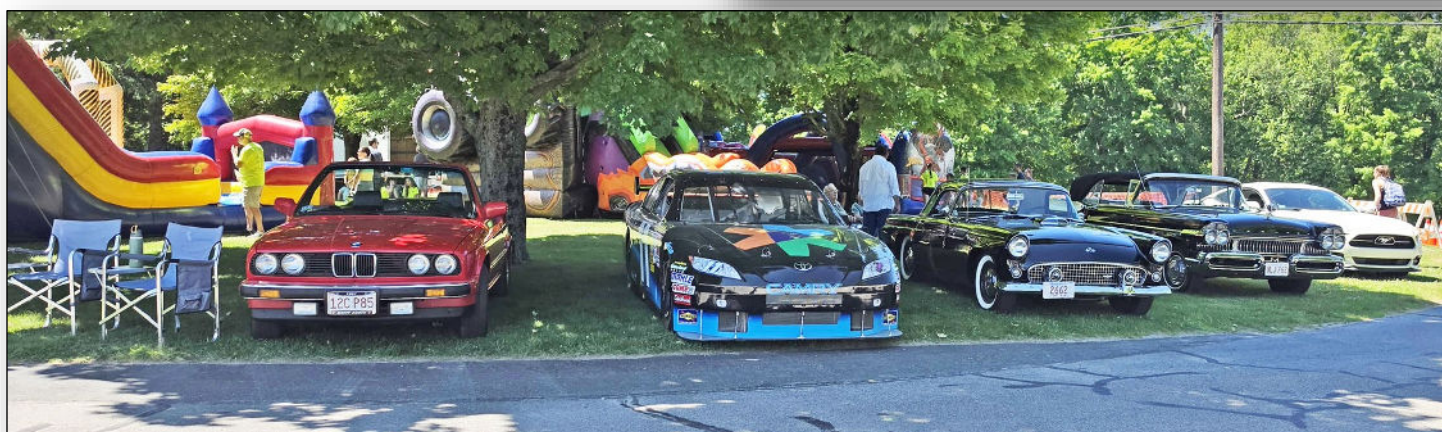

Mass Cruisers club member cars line both sides of the Norfolk Lions Annual Community Day event entrance road providing a mini-car show display



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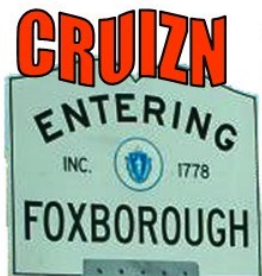
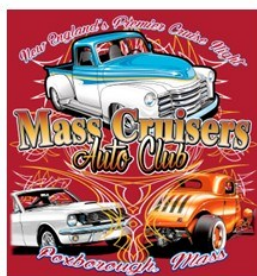

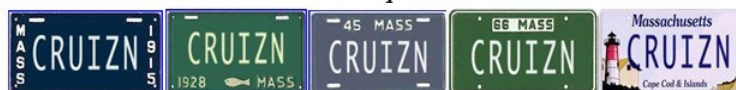
