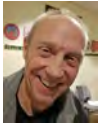

2026 Technical/Vocational Workforce Scholarships

May 21 was graduation day for all three Technical Vocational High Schools we support with the club's annual automotive workforce scholarship grants awarded to graduating students. For 2026 we awarded \$700.00 scholarship grants to each of the three following graduating seniors selected by their technical instructors based on criteria they will either be furthering their education or entering the workforce in their chosen automotive field:

Blue Hills Regional Technical High School – Riley Eldrege is a senior who is well known to the Mass Cruisers as having participated for 3 years in the annual engine build off competition held each March during the World on Wheels Showcase at Gillette Stadium. Riley is planning on expanding his automotive knowledge by attending the Mass Bay Community College Automotive program .

Norfolk County Agricultural High School – Tatiana Hernandez was a co-op student at Cummings Diesel. She was offered and accepted a scholarship from Cummings Diesel to attend Piedmont Community College's Diesel Technology program in Charlotte North Carolina.

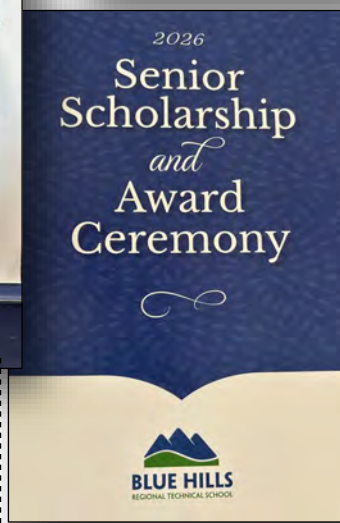
Southeastern Regional Vocational High School – Lana Morrissey is a senior in the Diesel/Automotive Program who has earned herself a 3.79 GPA. She plans to attend Mass Maritime for Marine Engineering (Diesel Technology) in the fall.

Our original scholarship program started back 30 years ago when we awarded \$300 to a single mom who was attending Blue Hills Regional Technical High School's Auto Body program and used it to complete her training course. Upon graduation, she was able to start her new career working at the Central Motors Auto Body Shop in Norwood. We have since been able to reinstate and expand the auto workforce scholarship grant program in recent years with your 50-50 donation proceeds at our Bass Pro Shops cruises. We have been giving out scholarships totaling \$7,400 to the three

Tech/Voke high schools since 2022. Billy Papadopoulos's 13 year old son Chris, confidently holding the Vintage Motorsports cruise winner plaque, must be looking forward to his senior year when he will be able to drive his prom date in his dad's 2024 Z06 Corvette. In an unusual twist for us, Bill's Corvette which has less than 500 miles on the odometer was selected as the cruise car of the night. Although brand new and not yet reaching the recommended 500 mile break-in period for street driving, this LT6 (rear mid 5.5L 670 HP V8 engine), is fitted with every available option including the Z07 performance package that includes the ZTK Trak Pak. Road & Track tests of the 2024 Z06 outperformed Ferrari 458 Italia, Porsche Cayman GT4 RS, McLaren 750S, Maserati MC20, BMW M4 CSL at 0-60 in 2.6 sec, 0-100 in 5.9 sec., quarter-mile 10.5 sec. @ 131 mph & top speed 195 mph making these Z06 Series Corvettes something special. Bill's plans for the Vette when he reaches the 1,500 mile period for track use are uncertain at this point because he's also got a big block '71 Chevelle project that he's owned since age 15 to complete, hopefully this year. Lucky Chris.

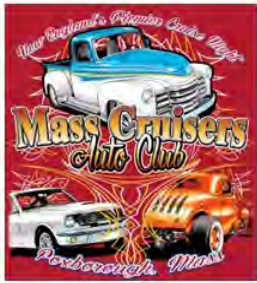
