A unique part of the Bay State Motor Festival is the noontime call to "START YOUR ENGINES", not a problem for our modern vehicles, but can be somewhat challenging for the much earlier vehicles that rely on hand-cranking to start. Ten year old River Bernstein had no problem firing up his restored air-cooled 4 cylinder 1906 Waltham built Orient Buckboard while the beautiful yellow 1906 Pawtucket built Cameron six cylinder air-cooled engine refused to fire up, stale fuel was to blame. The standout feature of the Bay State Motor Festival is its signature hallmark of bringing together examples of Massachusetts and New England built early automotive vehicles where enthusiasts can meet their owners and caretakers to learn details about the history and challenges they faced restoring and maintaining them.

JULY 16 CRUISE WINNER 1984 VW WESTFALIA CAMPER

It's not often vintage VW Westfalia Campers show up at cruise nights and, although the Gorman family from nearby Norwood, MA are regular Bass Pro Shops cruise attendees, I don't think they really expected to be recognized with our Vintage Motorsports Cruiser of the night award. Owner James Gorman and his family have been going camping every weekend in state parks all over New England for the past five years, racking up more than 30,000 miles since buying it from a friend. The Aussen Brown 1984 Camper was previously professionally restored at GoWesty Campers in California by the previous owner in 1999 and, other than converting the former propane cook stove & refrigerator to electric, he has continued to carefully preserve it. The original water cooled 1.9 liter 4 cyl. Engine was also rebuilt during the restoration into a bored and stroked 2.2 L high compression highway performing engine boosting the original 89 HP engine to a whopping 96 HP, and with the 4-speed manual tranny, she gets a respectable 19 mpg highway on premium. What a way to enjoy the old-car hobby!

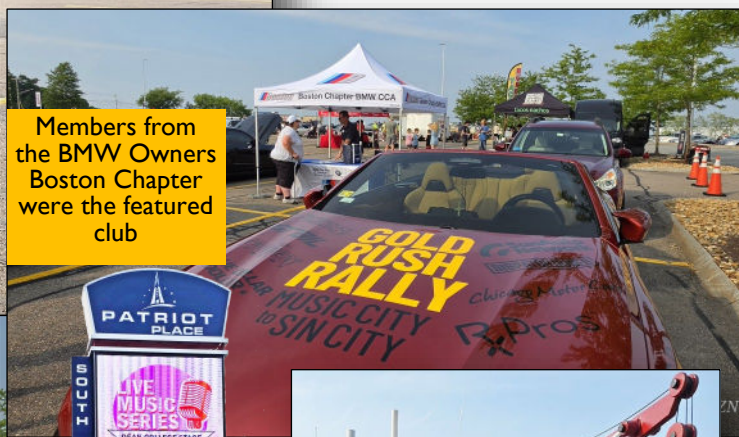

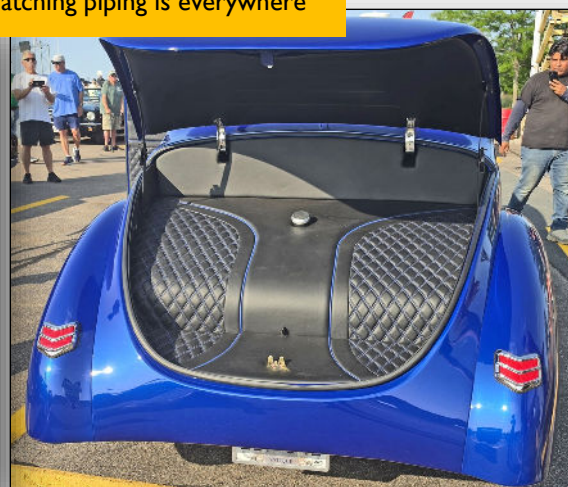
Although Eric Rhea from Cumberland, R.I. has owned his 1940 Ford 5-window Business Coupe for 16 years while living out in California, the long road to create his own customized street rod creation version started in his garage 10 years ago. The following year his job moved east to the Right Coast so he and his wife settled in Cumberland, R.I.. Meanwhile the '40 Coupe remained back on the Left Coast at Image Street Rods in Santa Maria, CA to continue its transformation each year racking up a total of 4,600 hours of custom build details and modifications that continued around a stroked Ford 522 cu. in. 700 HP V8 sitting in the modified Ford powder coated frame. Fitted with a Mustang II front end, 5-speed Tremec tranny and Ford 9 inch rear end with 4:11 gears and sitting underneath that custom blue painted all steel modified steel Ford and custom black diamond pleated leather interior, the finished street rod was shipped back East last month. Eric had logged a total of 312 miles after showing up at our July cruise and caught the attention of Cruise Director Bob Hines, a lifelong Ford owner, mechanic and enthusiast, to be selected for the deserving Vintage Motorsports cruise award. Congratulations Eric on your stunning Ford street rod.

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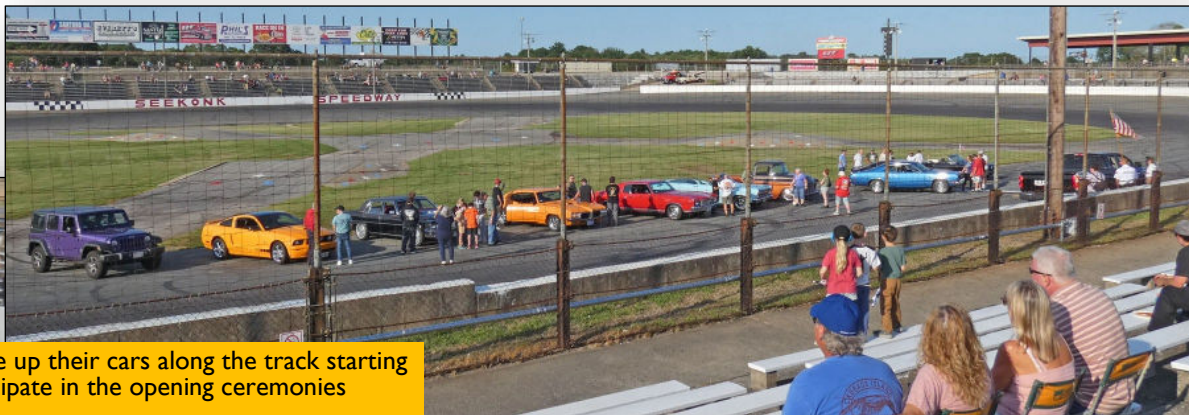

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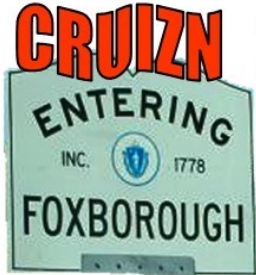
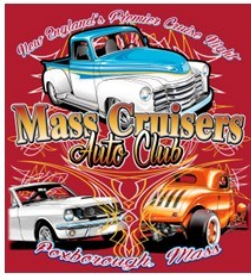
